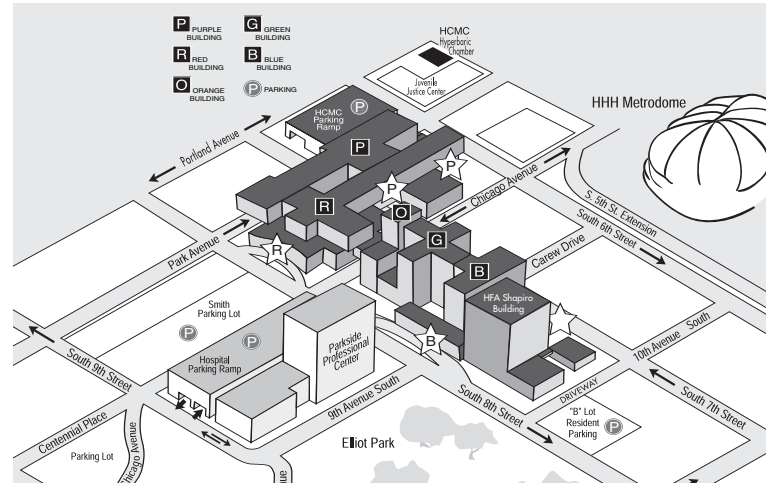


## Mission

- to educate physicians, nurses and other health care providers about geriatric care and to expand the scope of knowledge in geriatrics.

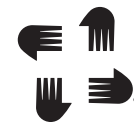
