The **Pediatric Brain Injury Program** is designed to meet the needs of children and adolescents with traumatic and other acquired brain injuries, many of whom have been treated at our Level 1 Trauma Center. The goals of the program are to help each patient, treatment and consulting services.

Trained **interpreters** are available in over 20 languages to help you and your child communicate with your care team.

## Our child and adolescent services

### Primary/Specialty Care

The **Pediatric Clinic at Hennepin County Medical Center** is a primary care and multi-specialty clinic located in the heart of downtown Minneapolis. We are an expert group of pediatric doctors and nurses providing top-notch and cutting edge care for infants, children, teens and young adults. We offer routine services including well child exams and vaccinations as well as care for when your child is sick. Because we are also a multi-specialty clinic, we have experience and expertise in treating a wide variety of serious and life-threatening health conditions.

Hennepin County Medical Center also operates four **community clinics** throughout Hennepin County. Located in Brooklyn Center, Richfield, and East and West Lake Street in Minneapolis, these clinics offer primary and specialty care for children and adolescents in convenient community locations.

### Inpatient and Intensive Care

A newly remodeled 18-bed **pediatric inpatient unit** is dedicated to meeting the emotional and physical needs of pediatric patients who need to be hospitalized.

The unit is equipped with in-room entertainment systems, a refurbished playroom, comfortable family rooms, and a transition area for kids and families coming from the ICU.

### The Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU)

provides care for infants, children, and adolescents who are critically ill or injured. Physicians who specialize in critical care, called pediatric intensivists, lead a team of nurses and allied medical professionals who are trained to care for the critically ill pediatric patient. Our younger critically ill patients will stay in the **Newborn Intensive Care Unit**, a 21-bed Level Three unit caring for infants in distress at birth, and those requiring close observation.

## Emergency and Urgently Needed Care

Hennepin County Medical Center is verified by the American College of Surgeons as a **Level 1 Trauma Center**, the highest level of trauma care. Our Pediatric Emergency Department specializes in the care of children age 16 and younger. Pediatric-trained physicians and nurses attend to more than 12,500 patient visits each year. This active unit specializes in child-centered services.

Our West Lake Street clinic in Minneapolis offers same day urgent care appointments.
