

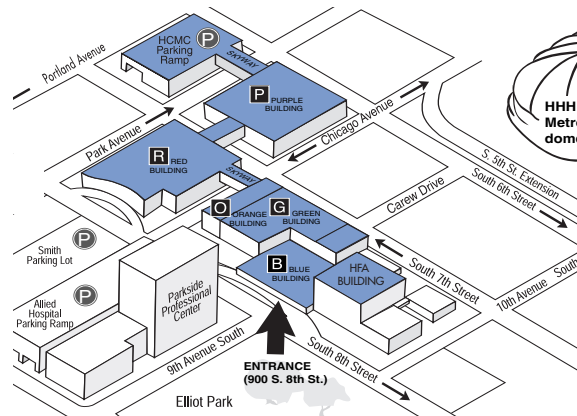
## ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Individual requires intense, interdisciplinary rehab program with at least three hours of therapy each day.
- Individual is medically, surgically and behaviorally stable enough to actively participate in the program, e.g., no fever, able to be out of bed, and willing to go to therapy.
- There is potential for the individual to return home after completion of the program.

Knapp's rehabilitation team of doctors, nurses, physical and occupational therapists, speech-language pathologists, neuropsychologists, therapeutic recreation specialists, and social workers work together to help individuals return to their highest level of independent functioning.

# KNAPP Rehabilitation Center:

The Miland E. Knapp Rehabilitation Center (Knapp) is an acute specialty area of HCMC serving adolescent and adult inpatients and outpatients. Knapp is part of the full service health care offered at the hospital. As part of the Level I Trauma Services at HCMC, Knapp is a primary provider of rehabilitation for the traumatically injured.

## Mission:

*The primary mission of the Miland E. Knapp Rehabilitation Center is to provide intensive, integrated, quality programs and services for individuals with physical and cognitive impairment without discrimination on the basis of disability, ethnicity, creed, color, sexual orientation or socioeconomic status.*

## Facts about KNAPP

- We have served persons with activity limitations for more than 30 years.
- Eighty percent of patients who have completed our inpatient program have been discharged to their homes. Others may need to continue rehab after leaving Knapp.
- We accept individuals who require inpatient or outpatient care.
- We accept all insurance (some companies have special regulations regarding rehabilitation care), Medicare, and Medicaid.
- Knapp is recognized by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities for its excellence in comprehensive rehabilitative care with a special accreditation in brain injury rehab.



Our patient population includes individuals ages 13 and older with conditions such as:

## Neurological:

- Brain Injury
